CRITICAL THINKING ASSIGNMENT HISTORY 1006 PERSPECTIVES ON AMERICA AT WAR

Using the documents available to you in your textbook, pretend that you are an agent for a foreign government residing in the United States. It is November 30, 1941. You have been asked by your government to write an assessment of the likelihood of the United States becoming a participant in either, or both, of the two wars raging at that time. With the evidence available to you, and without considering any events which occur after the end of November 1941, write a 750 -1000 word appraisal of what you would see as America's current position. Consider the public policy and popular opinion of the time.

This assignment must be typed and double-spaced. All work must be your own! You may consult the tutoring center, but do not confer with other members of the class. The paper is due in class on **February 20th**, **2019**.
